



Title IX Discrimination Voluntary Informal Resolution Form

Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 (20 U.S.C. § 1681) is a federal law that prohibits discrimination based on the sex of students in educational institutions that receive federal financial assistance. When a Formal Complaint of sexual harassment has been filed, the District may facilitate an informal resolution process. This process is voluntary. Any party may decline to participate. If the parties agree to participate in the informal resolution process, the investigation may be abated for a short period of time to allow the parties to concentrate their efforts on resolution. This form is to be used to document the results of any voluntary informal resolution process. A copy of any agreement must be provided to the parties and the Title IX Coordinator.
