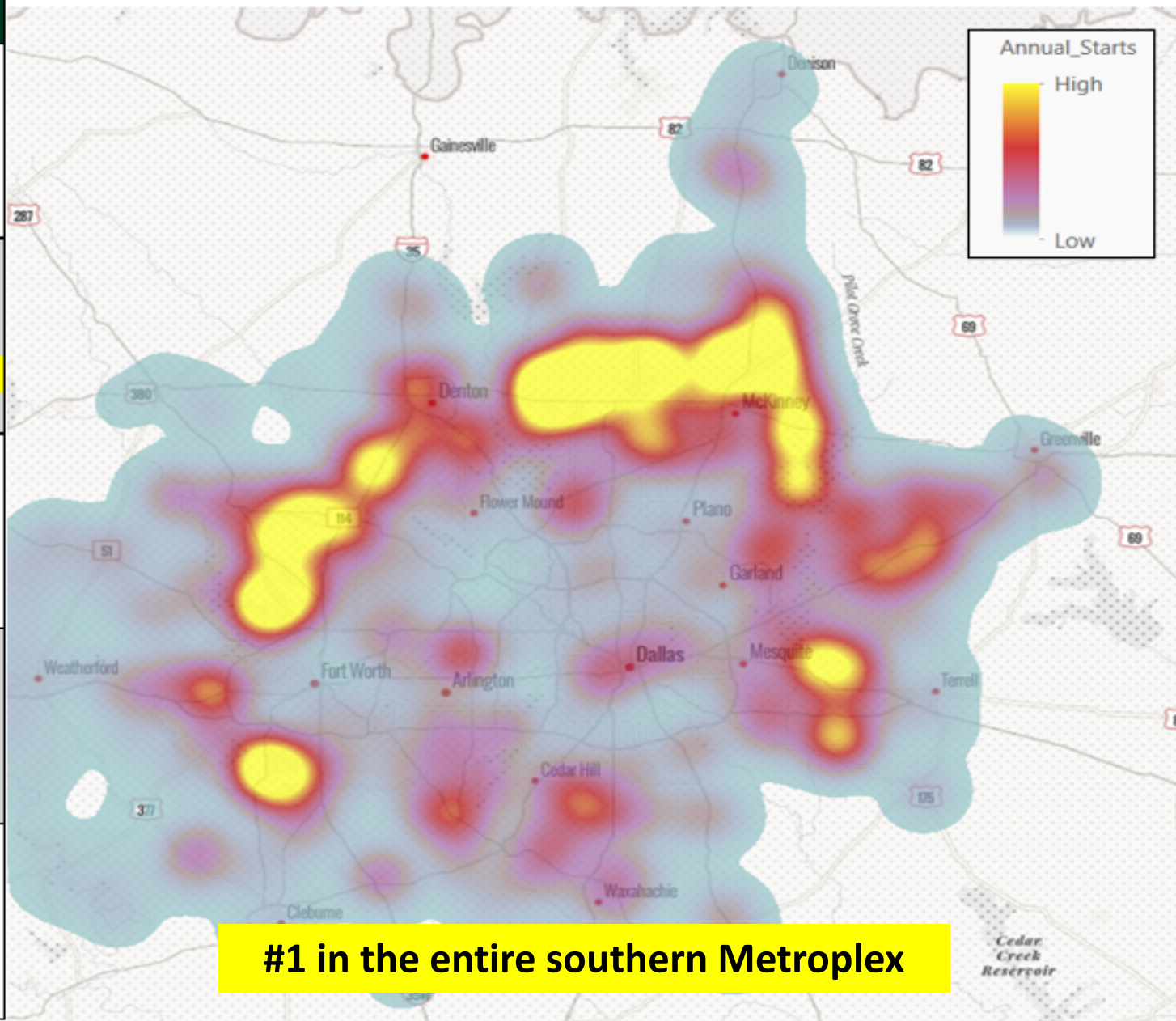

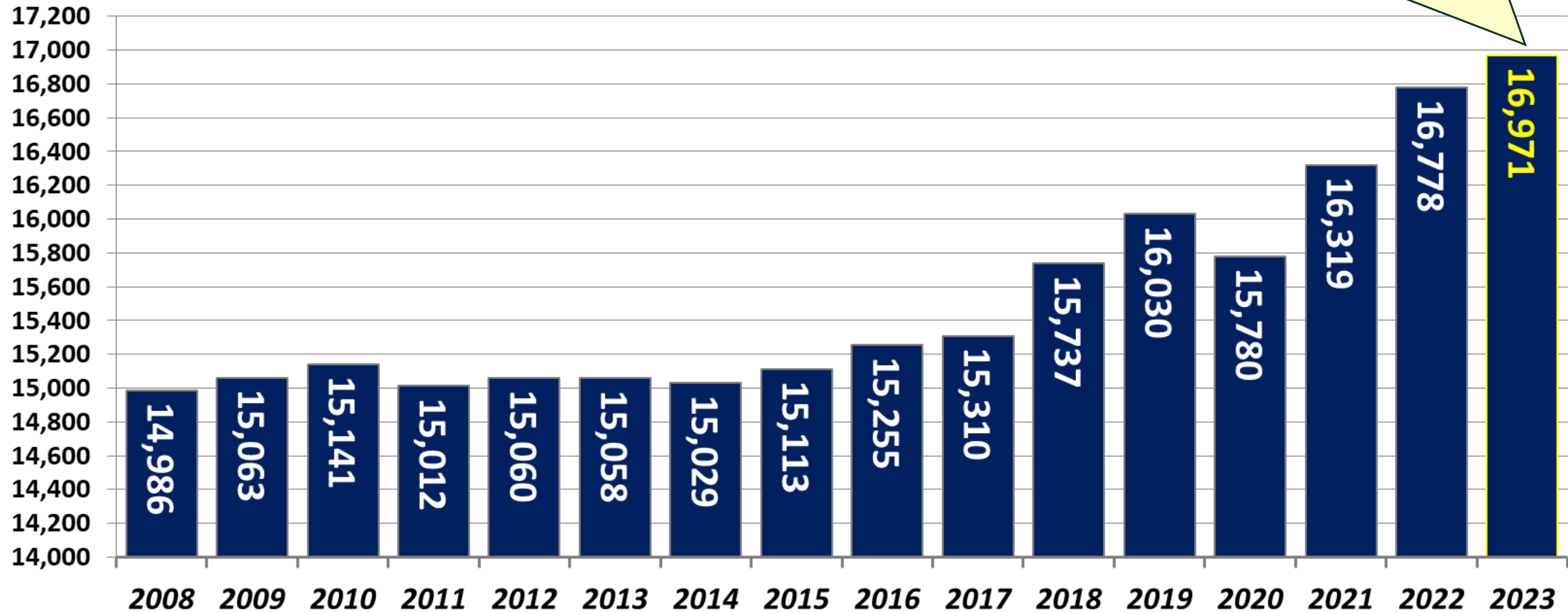


CROWLEY ISD ENROLLMENT GROWTH (PK-12): 15-YEAR HISTORY

March 2024: 17,178 students!

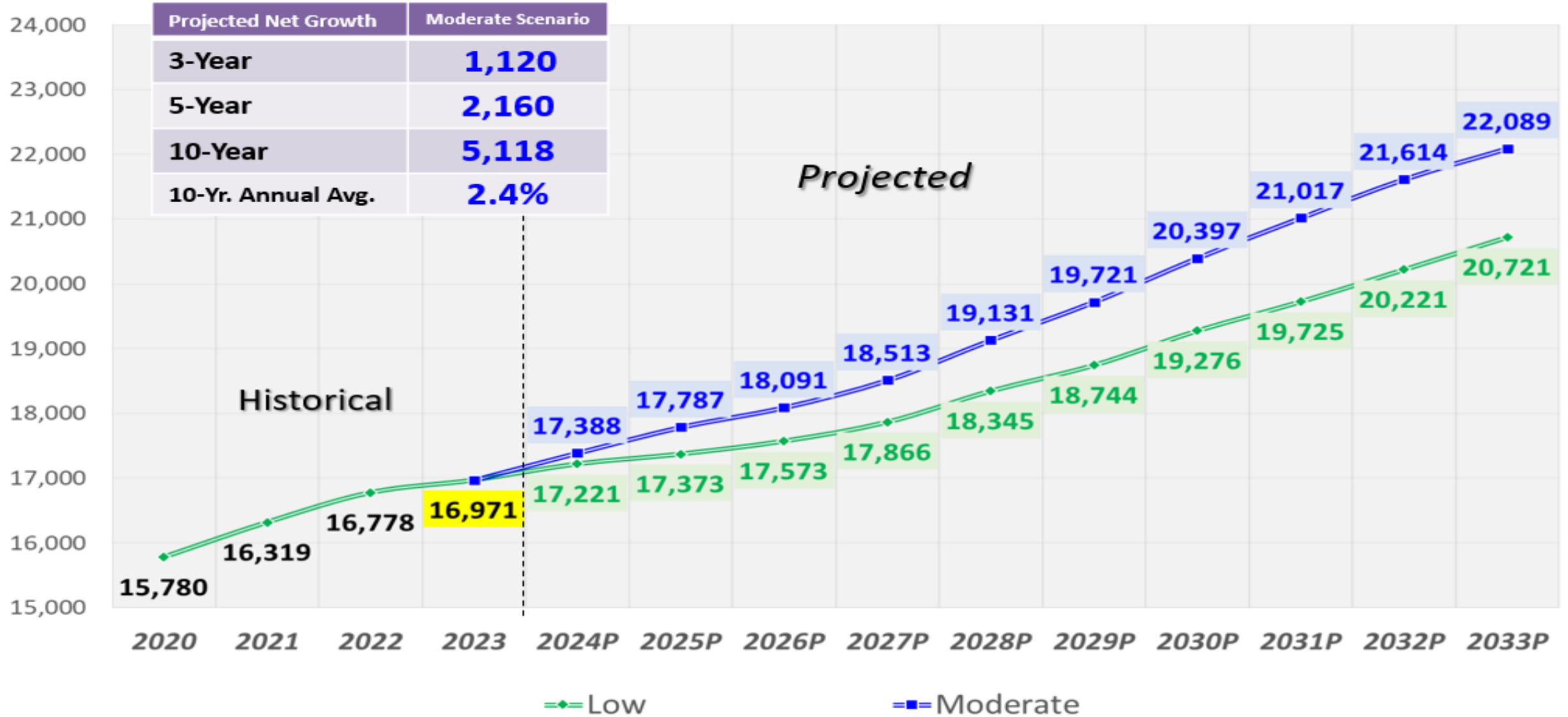
Crowley ISD - Enrollment History (PK-12)





DISTRICT ENROLLMENT PROJECTIONS

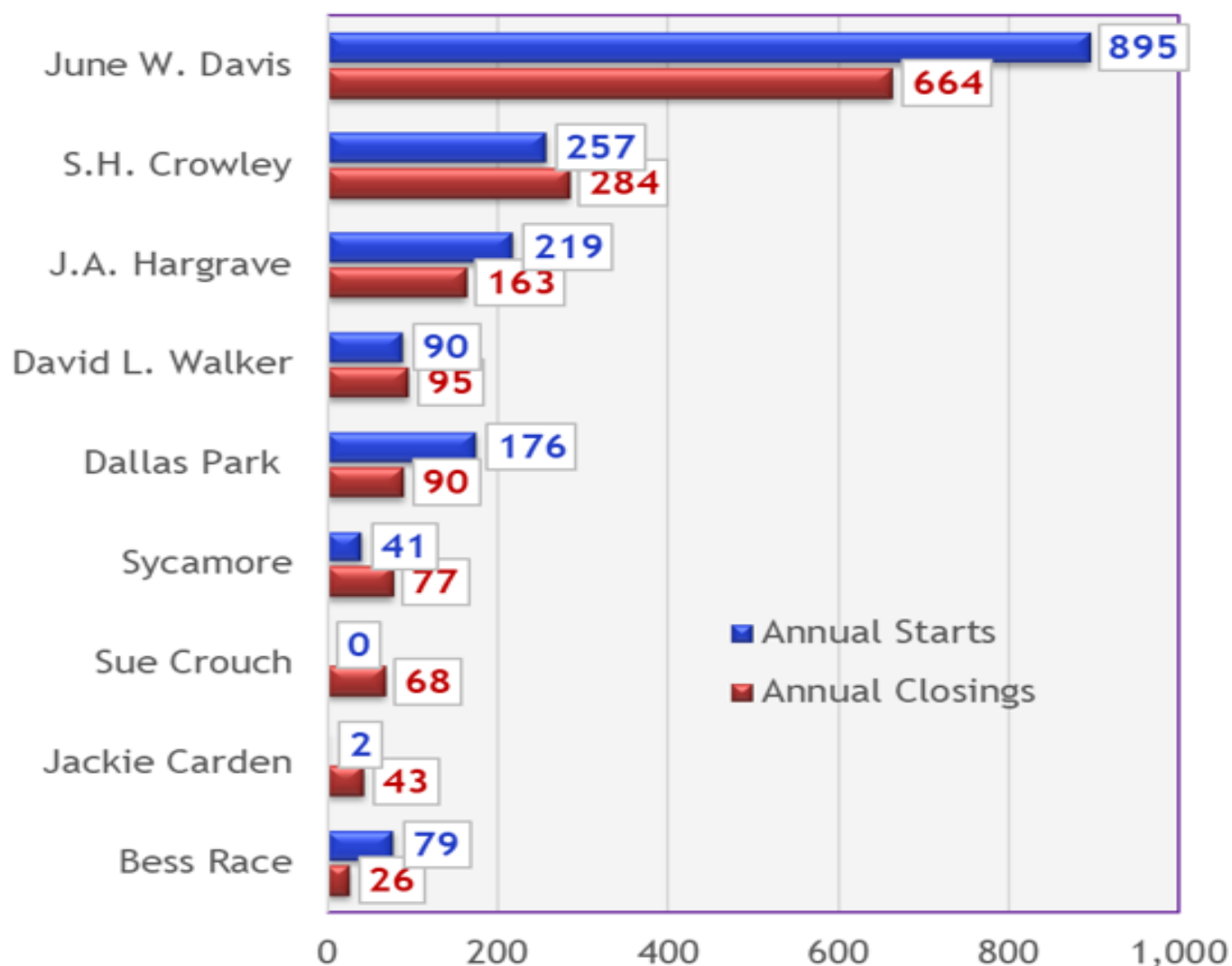

What is Rezoning?

- Redrawing school attendance boundaries
- Maintain safe, equitable distribution of students among different schools
- Necessary as communities grow and new schools are built

What Factors are Considered?

- Capacity of campuses
- Demographic factors
- Projected enrollment
- Geographical proximity
- Transportation patterns
- Minimize the impact on families

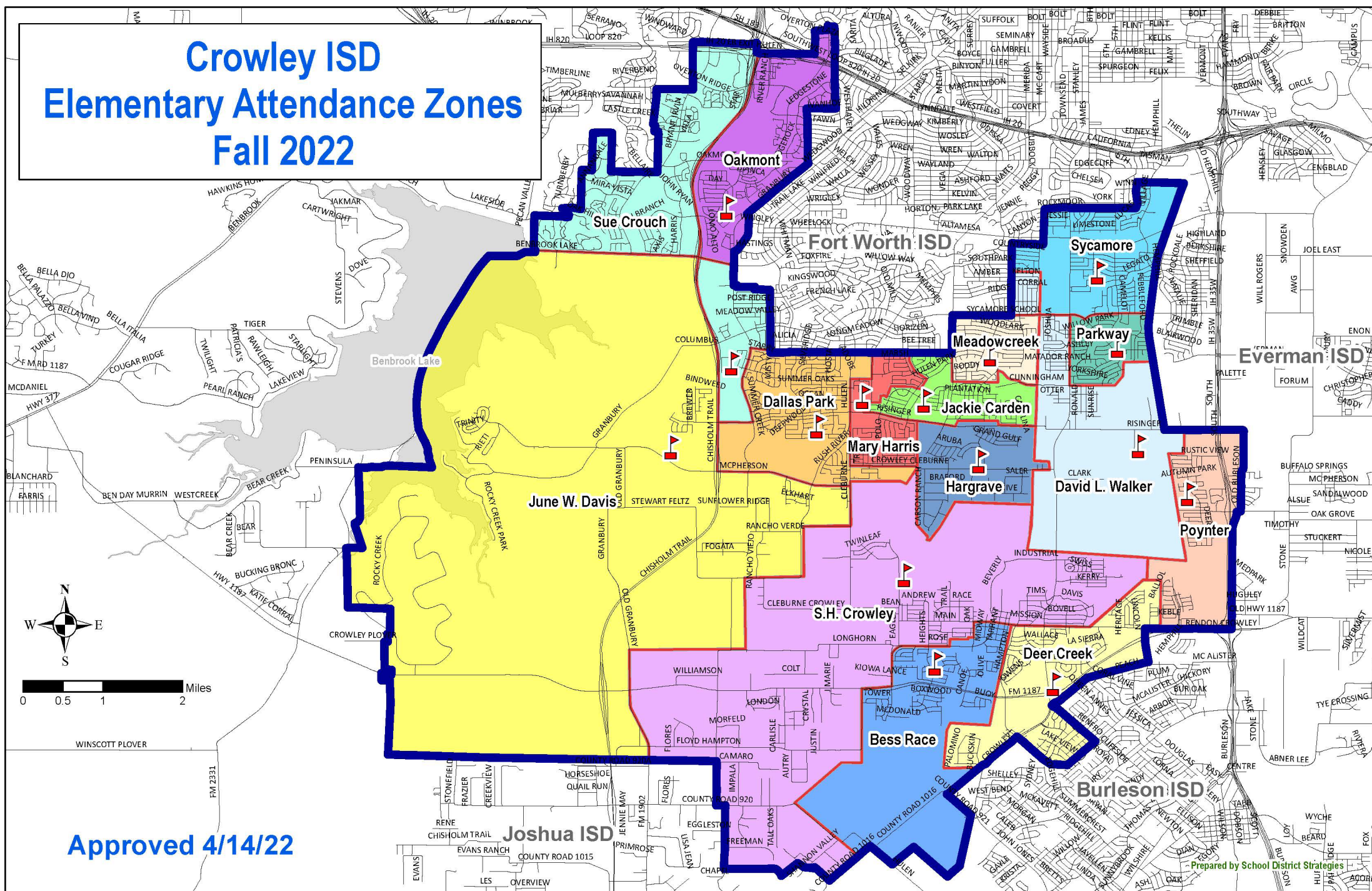

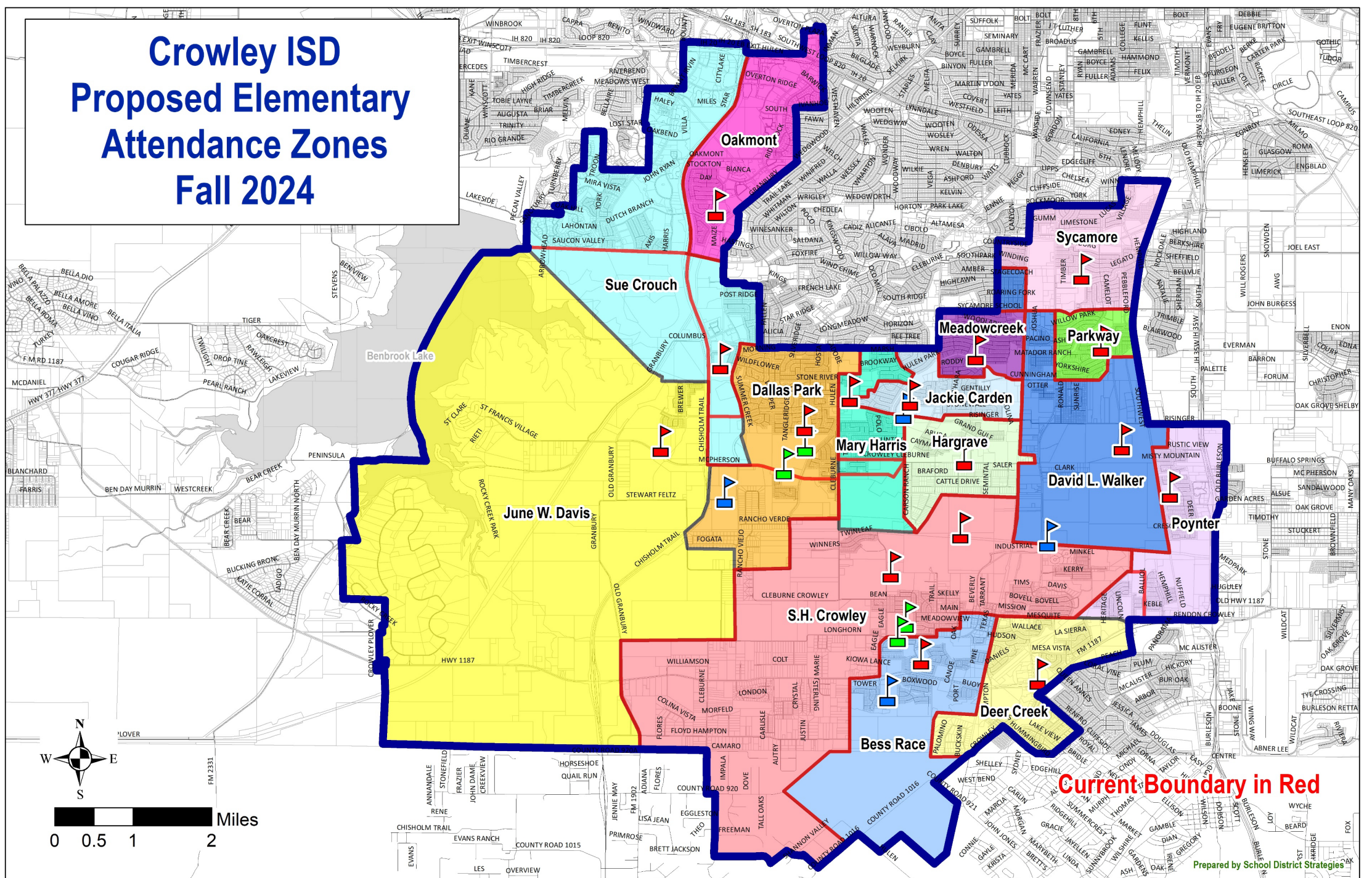
Proposed Changes to Elementary Attendance Zone

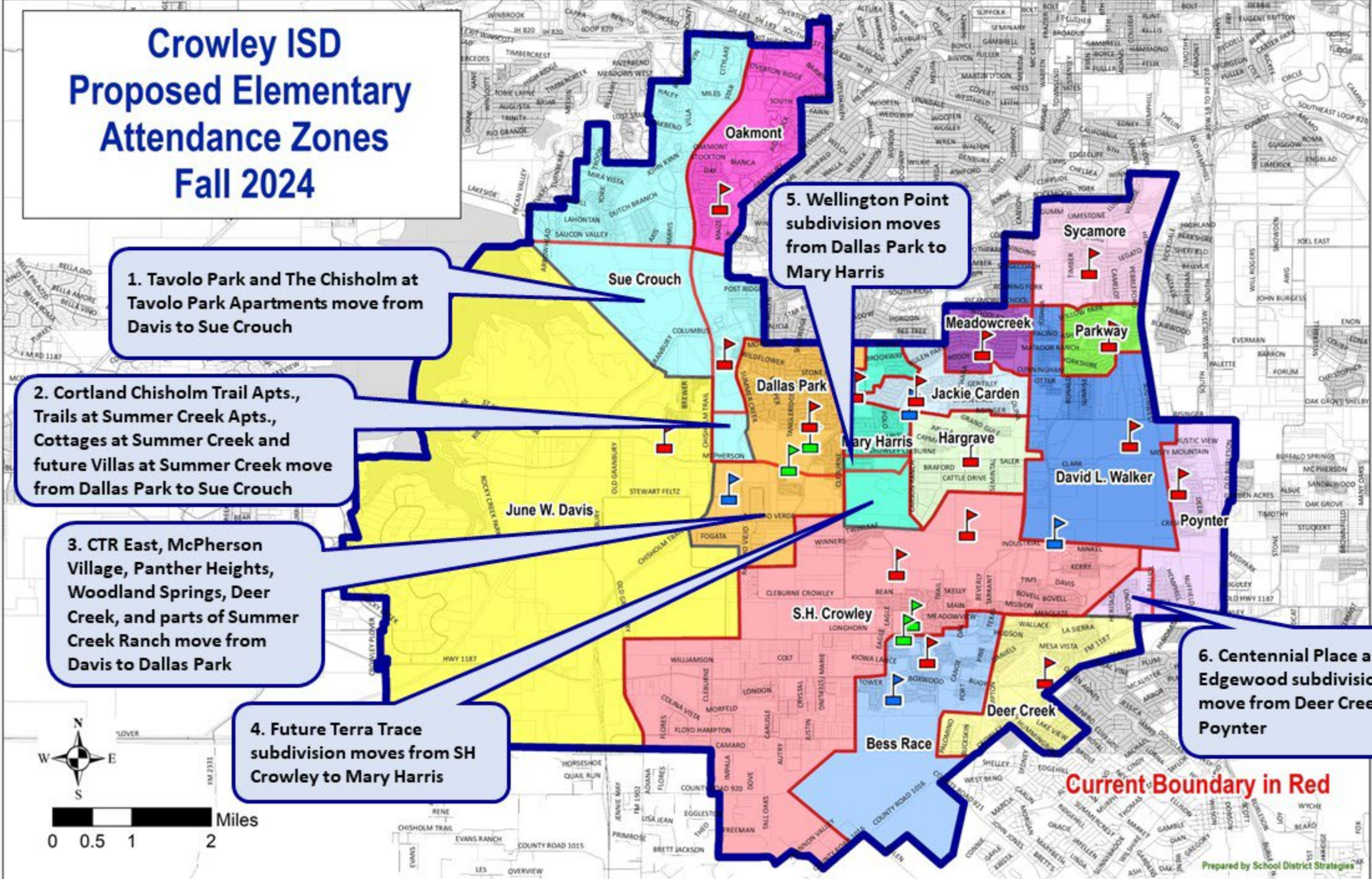
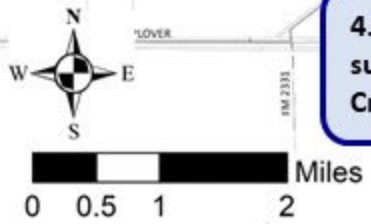
3. CTR East, McPherson Village, Panther Heights, Woodland Springs, Deer Creek, and parts of Summer Creek Ranch move from Davis to Dallas Park

4. Future Terra Trace subdivision moves from SH Crowley to Mary Harris

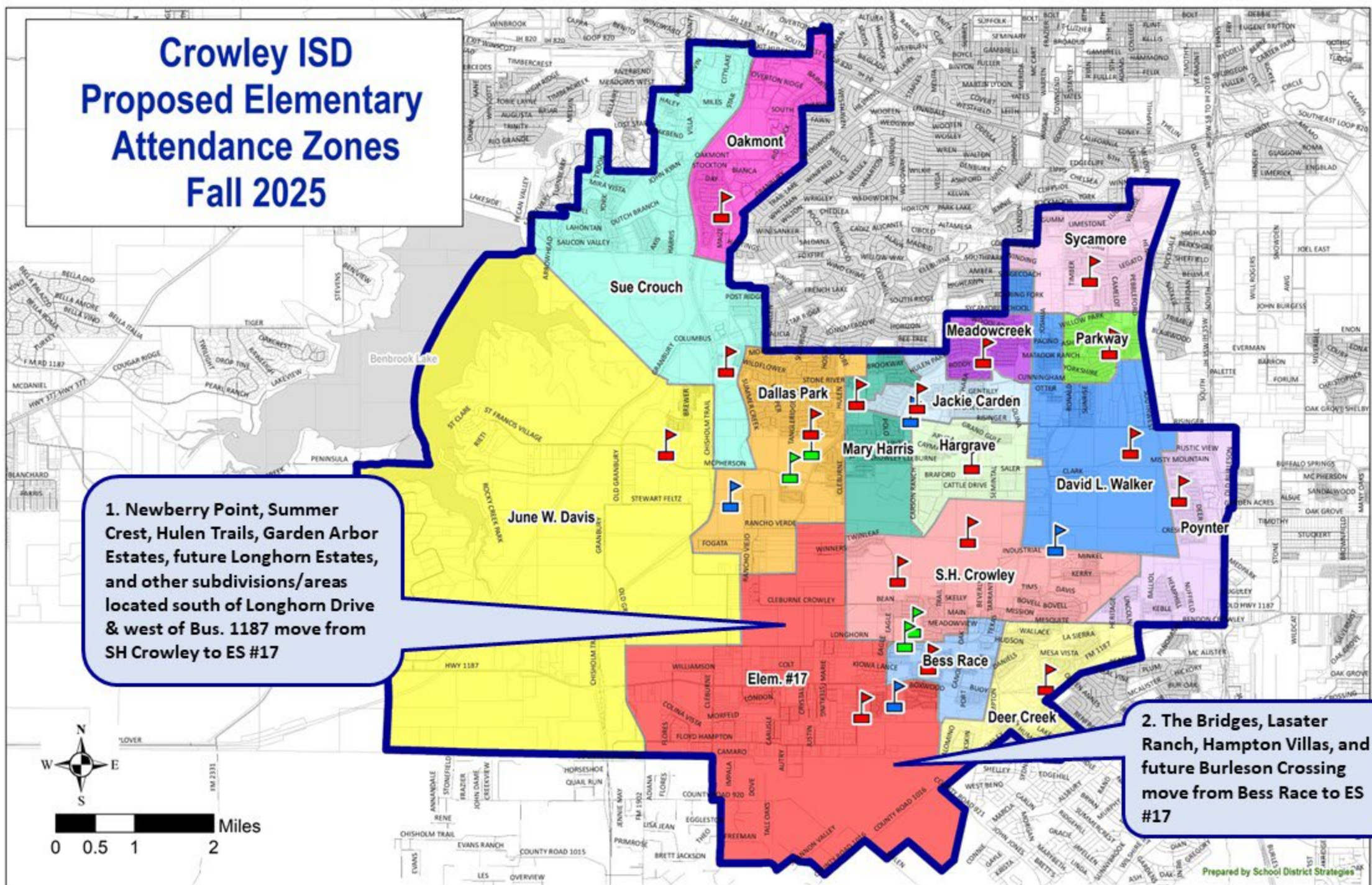
5. Wellington Point subdivision moves from Dallas Park to Mary Harris

2. The Bridges, Lasater Ranch, Hampton Villas, and future Burleson Crossing move from Bess Race to ES #17
